Description	Use	Priority
Magnet /Total school (MS)	Student is enrolled at a magnet school through the magnet process	✓
VEEP (VP)	Student is enrolled at a VEEP receiving school through the VEEP process	✓
Open Enrollment (Choice - CH)	Student enrolled through the School Choice process	✓
Prgm Imprv SchI Choice (PI)	Student is enrolled through the PISC process from a PI school.	✓
Bilingual Transfer (BT)	Student attending school for bilingual program not offered at resident school.	
Caregiver Affidavit (CG)	Student attending a school with a Caregiver Affidavit	
Charter Request (CR)	Student attending a Charter School	
Child Care Affidavit (CA)	Student attending an elementary school with a child care affidavit	
Grandfathered Bound Chg (G4)	Students enrolled with boundary changes approved by the Board of Education	
Homeless/Temp residence (HM)	Student enrolled is Homeless or in Temporary Residence	
Interdistrict Permit (4J)	Student enrolled with an approved interdistrict attendance permit though the Choice process	
Interdist Permit Employment (EI)	Student is on enrolled with an employment-related interdistrict attendance permit through the Choice process	
Inter-SELPA Agreement (IS)	Student enrolled on an Inter-SELPA agreement through Special Education	
Move/Continue School Year (4C)	Student was originally eligible as a resident or other valid transfer and has moved and appears to be ineligible(4C, VP2, MS2)	
Optional Attendance (OA)	Student resides in an optional attendance area	
Overcrowded Facilities (CF)	Student transferred due to overcrowded facilities	
Schl Init Plcmt/Agreement (SP)	Student is enrolled through School Initiated Placement (SIP) at an independent study or continuation school	
Schl Init Plcmt/SIP Council (SC)	Student is enrolled through SIP council placement	
Seminar (CH4)	Student attending school for seminar program not offered at resident school	
Senior Student - Grade 12 (SR)	Student is a enrolled to complete the 12 th grade	
Special Ed Day Class (4F)	Student enrolled as a nonresident special education student	
Address Verification Pending (AV)	A temporary code to be used when the address cannot be verified.	
District-Run School Option (DO)	Student attending the District Option school instead of the Charter school.	
Specialized Course (CH2)	Student enrolled through School Choice with specialized course priority	
Choice Artic criteria 3 (G3)	Student grandfathered into School Choice from before 1994-95 school year (2006/07 is the last year for this code).	
DISC 04-05;Magnet/Program (MP)	Discontinued code - DO NOT USE

Prgm Imprv Schl Choice (PI)	Student is enrolled through the PISC process from a PI school.	✓
None	Use when only one code (transfer type) is necessary	
Caregiver Affidavit (CG)	Student attending a school with a Caregiver Affidavit	
Child Care Affidavit (CA)	Student attending an elementary school with a child care affidavit	
Cont, based on prev elig (6)	A student continuing in pattern based on a previous year's eligibility (i.e. change in VEEP pattern)	
Homeless/Temp residence (HM)	Student enrolled is Homeless or in Temporary Residence	
Interdistrict Permit (4J)	Student enrolled with an approved interdistrict attendance permit through the Choice process	
Interdist Permit Employment (EI)	Student is on enrolled with an employment-related interdistrict attendance permit through the Choice process	
Move / Continue School Year (4C)	Student was originally eligible as a resident or other valid transfer and has moved and appears to be ineligible(4C, VP2, MS2)	
Overcrowded Facilities (CF)	Student transferred due to overcrowded facilities	
Schl Init Plcmt/Agreement (SP)	Student is enrolled through School Initiated Placement (SIP) at an independent study or continuation school	
Schl Init Plcmt/SIP Council (SC)	Student is enrolled through SIP council placement	
Seminar (CH4)	Student attending school for seminar program not offered at resident school	
Special Ed Day Class (4F)	Student enrolled as a nonresident special education student	
Senior Student - Grade 12 (SR)	Student is a enrolled to complete the 12 th grade
