

Master Schedule Editor: Interpreting SDUSD Error Messages

Effective April 2008, you will see district-specific error messages when creating or editing sections in Master Schedule Editor. These “data validations” were implemented by the IT Department to help you follow district guidelines and also avoid common mistakes. There are three types of errors: **warnings**, **information**, and **problems**.

Error Type	Icon	Can user still save?	Button option(s)
Warning	Question mark	Yes. This is a warning only.	Yes/No
Information	Information bubble	Yes. This is an informational message only.	OK
Problem	Exclamation point	No. The user must fix the error prior to saving.	OK

Use this job aid to look up and resolve SDUSD errors when using Master Schedule Editor.



Information

Icon: Information bubble

Can user still save? Yes. This is an informational message only.

Error code	What the error says	Where the error occurs	How to resolve the error
2001	The Mark Definition: [mark def] has been removed. A Mark Definition is not needed if Assign Grades is off.	Mark Definition	Informational only. No action necessary.



Warning

Icon: Question Mark

Can user still save? Yes. This is a warning only.

2000	The Course Definition for: [course] indicates Assign Grades should be on. Do you wish to correct this?	Assign Grades	Check to see if you accidentally changed the Assign Grades setting for the section. Normally schools should not make changes to the default setting. If students will

2002	The Course Definition for: [course] indicates Post To History should be on. Do you wish to correct this?	Post To History	Check to see if you accidentally changed the Post To History setting for the section. Normally schools should not make changes to the default setting. If this section should appear on student transcripts then Post To History must be on.
2003	The Course Definition for: [course] indicates Take Attendance should be on. Do you wish to correct this?	Take Attendance	Check to see if you accidentally changed the Take Attendance setting for the section. Normally schools should not make changes to the default setting. If attendance should be taken for this class then Take Attendance must be on.
2004	The Course Definition for: [course] indicates Count Attendance should be on. Do you wish to correct this?	Count Attendance	Check to see if you accidentally changed the Count Attendance setting for the section. Normally schools should not make changes to the default setting. If attendance should be counted towards ADA for this class then Count Attendance must be on.
2005	The Classroom has not been assigned for this section. Do you wish to correct this?	Classroom	Please select a Classroom for the section. If the correct classroom is missing from the drop-down ask your Power User to add the classroom using Classroom Editor.

Icon: Exclamation point

Error code	What the error says	Where the error occurs	How to resolve the error
2013	There is a problem with this combination of Term, Mark Definition, and Course. Term: [term] Mark Definition: [mark def] Course: [course]	Term, Mark Definition, Course	Refer to the job aid Mark Definitions Guidelines for information about which courses are allowed to be used with this combination of Term and Mark Definition. This error occurs if you are using Terms: All Semesters, All Year (qtr), or All Year (6 term).
2014	There is a problem with this combination of Term, Mark Definition, and Course. Term: [term] Mark Definition: [mark def] Course: [course]	Term, Mark Definition, Course	This error occurs if you are using Term: Elementary All Year with an inappropriate course.
2015	The Term: [term] cannot be used when scheduling elementary courses.	Term	This error occurs if you are using Terms: Elementary Cycle 1, Elementary Cycle 2, or Elementary Cycle 3. Schools should use Term: Elementary All Year.
